Also, reading of literature and exposure to cinema gives this lesson of trying persistently unless we succeed, for example Lagaan, Bhag Milkha Bhaag movies.

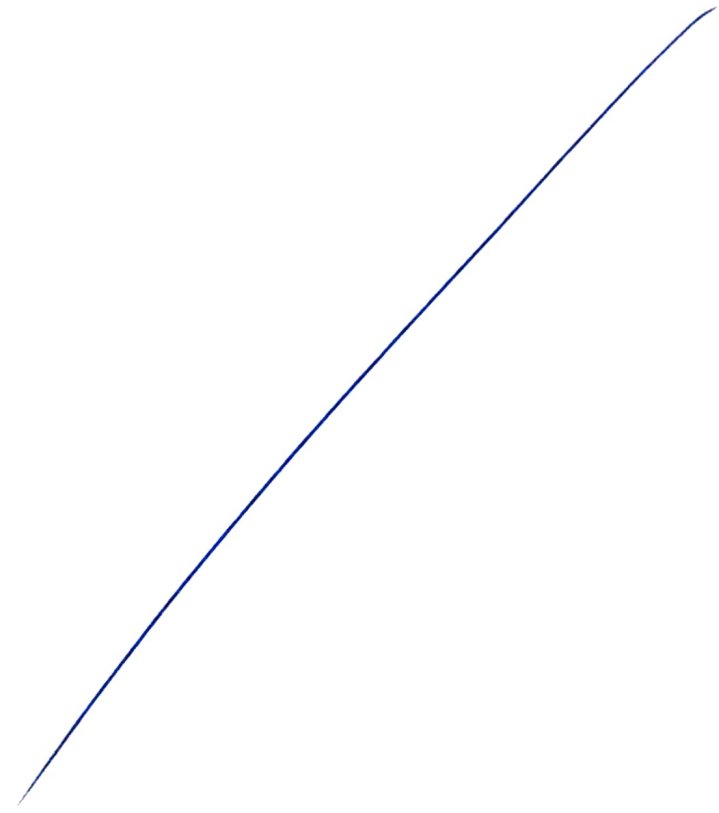
Therefore, the earlier we understand this mantra of life, the better it is since it is also said that no success is final and no failure is fatal. On understanding this we can move on the path
