A bureaucrat resisting political pressure to manipulate a welfare scheme shows responsibility guided by integrity and public interest.

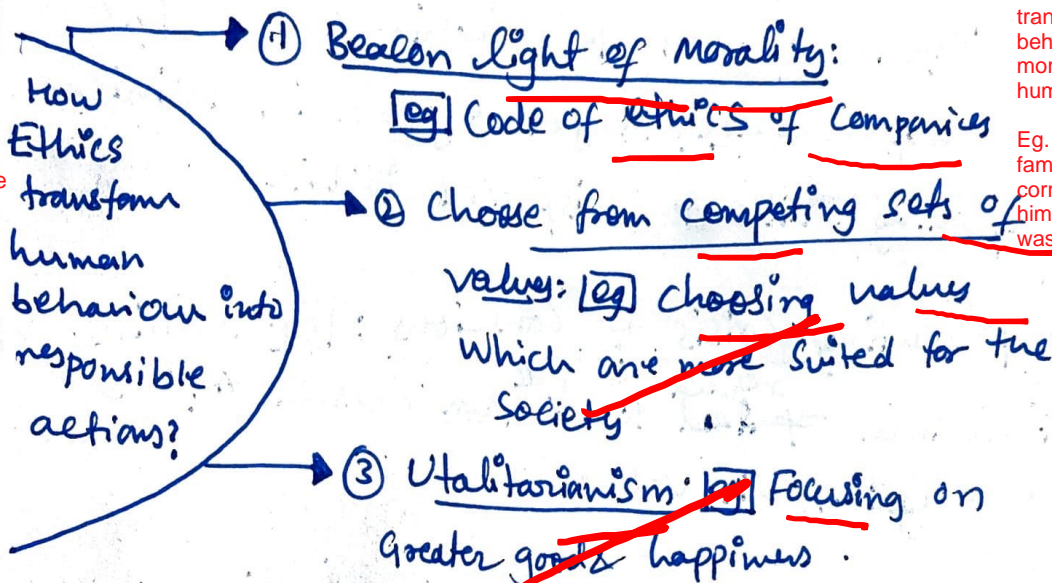
Eg. Durga Shakti Nagpal against sand mafia and political pressure

Ethics are the set of principles that enable us to choose from what's right and what is our right to do.

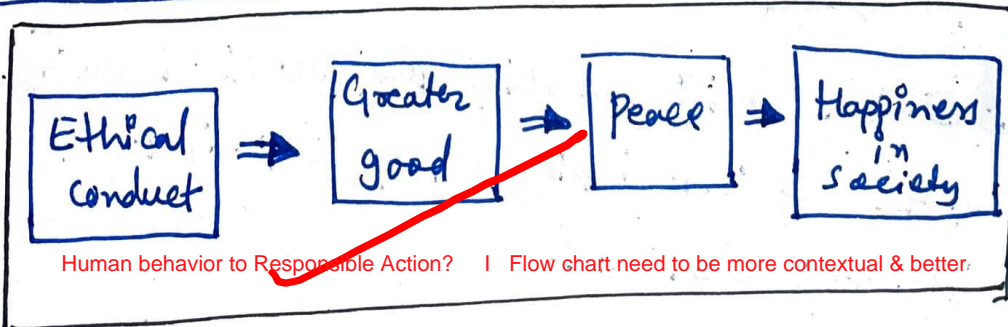
Behaviour can be impulsive or influenced by external factors, it is ethical reflection that transforms such behavior into conscious, morally responsible human action.
